



At Home with Homeopathy

I've been focussed in recent years on providing online continuing education courses for students & practitioners of homeopathic medicine. I'd like in this course to extend my reach to individuals & families wishing to manage their own homeopathic home care of common acute illnesses & injuries. As it's been my experience that an informed & educated patient population is of great benefit to the any healthcare professional, I'd like to welcome students and practitioners of homeopathy into this offering as well, to facilitate their development of home care classes within their own practices.

We'll begin with an examination of resources needed for homeopathic home care; recommendations of books and web-based resources to extend what will be taught in this course, and to serve as bedside references in working with common acute illnesses & injuries; along with sources of homeopathic remedies & remedy kits. I'll discuss the scope of home care, and the role of healthcare professionals; how to identify and work effectively as a team with healthcare professionals, including discussion of how professional attention might be integrated with home care in the context of common acute illnesses.

We'll move on to cover the homeopathic management of a number of commonly-encountered conditions; including:

- Common injuries (sprains/strains, lacerations, puncture wounds, & abrasions, burns, cartilage, tendon, & soft-tissue injuries),
- Common acute discomforts & illnesses of infants (teething difficulties, sleep issues, "colic," roseola, croup)
- Common infectious diseases of children (chickenpox, rotovirus & other infectious diarrheas, measles, mumps, whooping cough)
- Common upper respiratory illnesses in older children & adults; coughs, sore throats, colds, & 'flu.

Each of these, of course, comes with its own set of caveats re potentially serious consequences which may require the attention of a trained healthcare professional; we'll discuss these as well, including how to engage and work as a self-advocacy team with professionals when this is advisable.

I'm hoping that this course might be a useful resource for participants to identify other like-minded individuals to partner with, either locally or at a distance bridged by cyber-connection, in informal study-groups for further study and to access home care support.
